- All participants/entrants will have their time recorded, but participants must be aware this is a participation event, NOT A RACE
- All participants/entrants must undertake the appropriate training and exercise required in order to complete the course
- All participants/entrants must abide by Queensland road rules at all times whilst training leading up to the event and during the event
- All participants/entrants must have a road worthy bicycle for the event
- All participants/entrants take part in the event at their own risk and will be required to sign a disclaimer prior to starting the event
- All participants/entrants completing the entire course (100kml or 160kml) must be 15 years of age or older on the day of the event. Any under the age of 18 years of age will be required to have a consent form signed by a parent or guardian
- Participants/entrants within the age bracket of 12 to 15 years of age are eligible to enter the event as part of a team and can do up a total of 50kml
